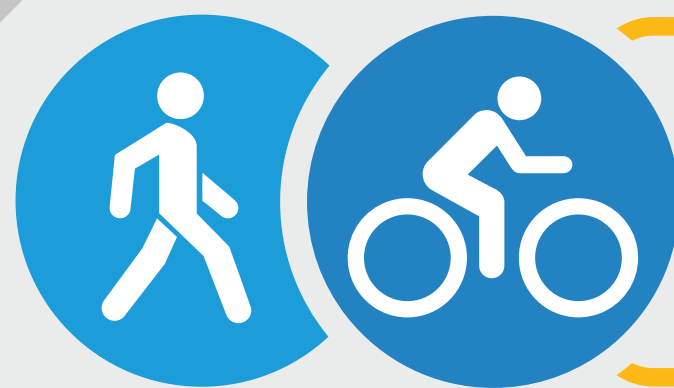
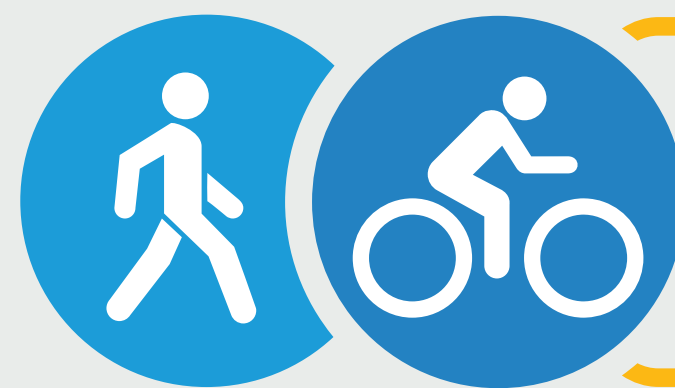




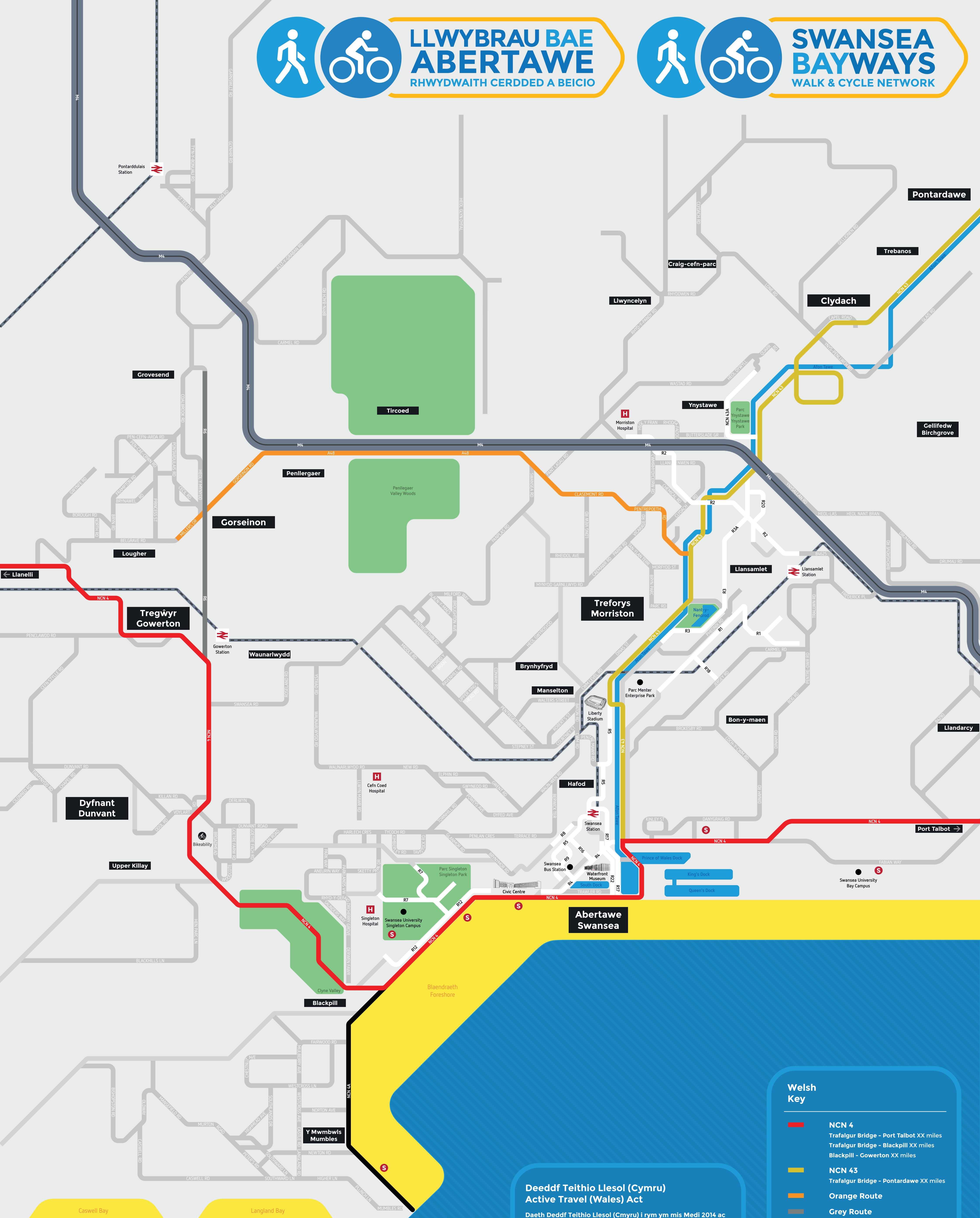

Deeddf Teithio Llesol (Cymru) Active Travel (Wales) Act

Daeth Deddf Teithio Llesol (Cymru) i rym ym mis Medi 2014 ac mae'n golygu bod dyletswyddar awdurdodau lleol ledled Cymru yn awr i gynllunio ar gyfer llwybrau a chyfleusterau cerdded a beicio gwell a'u darparu. The Active Travel (Wales) Act came into force in September 2014 and means that local Authorities across Wales now have a duty to plan for and deliver improved walking and cycling routes and facilities. This map shows the many shared use paths that are available in and around Swansea Bay.
